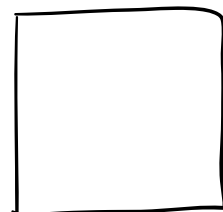

Find these **plants** in our *Temalpakh* Garden. *Temalpakh* means 'From the Earth' in Cahuilla!

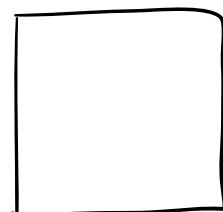
### Desert Agave

This plant can be used for food and building material.



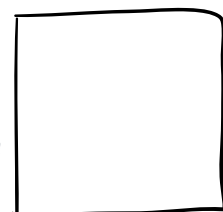
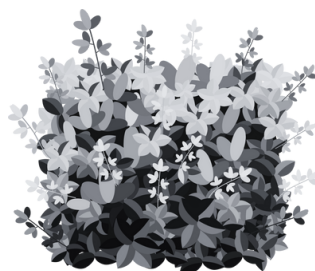
### Mesquite Tree

This tree produces seed pods that sometimes taste sweet.



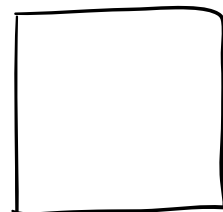
### Buckwheat

This bush produces flowers that when processed can be eaten.



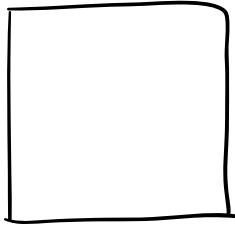
### Deer Grass

The reeds of this plant are used to make coil baskets.



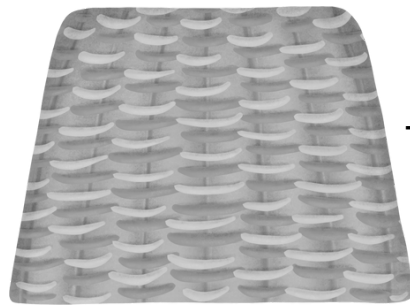
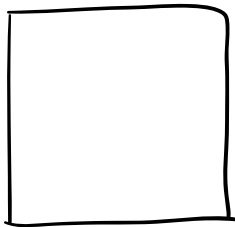

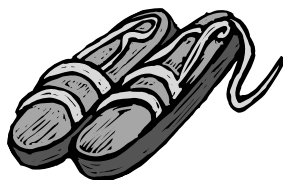
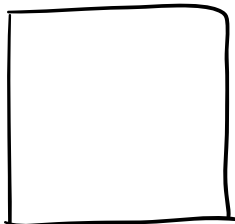
## Coil Basket

This style of basket weaving is very sturdy and beautiful.



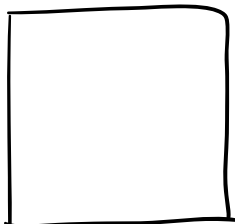
## Grainery
